RESPONSIBILITES:

- Handle cases before the Mental Health Judges of the Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court.
- Represent indigent defendants on the Mental Health dockets throughout the criminal process, including initial hearings, plea negotiations, trial, sentencing, and postconviction supervision proceedings.
- Attend mental health staffings and work on treatment/release plans.
- Handle competency, sanity and conditional release hearings.
- Assist with the representation of felony defendants in non-Mental Health cases, as needed.
- Respond to requests for legal assistance from individuals with criminal issues who contact the Public Defender's Office.
- Participate in community events and meetings related to the work of the Cuyahoga County Public Defender.
- Must be available for court at all times court is open, and be available to meet and work outside the normal working hours if necessary.
- Must be able to perform all other duties assigned, delegated or required of the assistant public defenders as well as those prescribed by law

EXPERIENCE AND SKILLS

- The applicant must be a licensed attorney in Ohio or have the ability to waive into the Ohio bar.
- The applicant must have a minimum three years of prior criminal legal experience.
- A desire to represent individuals with serious mental health issues and/or developmental disabilities.

- The ability to work as a team member with social workers, community providers, probation officers to coordinate treatment/release plans.
- Strong communication skills and the ability to effectively communicate with severely mental ill or developmentally delayed clients
- Experience with and/or knowledge of mental health and/or developmental disabilities.
- A capacity to work creatively and collaboratively on legal issues confronting our indigent clients.
- A demonstrated commitment to the representation of indigent individuals and an understanding of how systemic societal issues affect individuals and families.
- The ability to engage knowledgeably and compassionately with clients who are experiencing mental health concerns, substance abuse, and trauma.
